## Novice Division Guidelines

Novice Division participants need to decide at the beginning of the season which division they will ride in. Horse and or rider can only compete in one division.

Novice Youth is any rider age 19 and under that has not loped in any class.

Novice Adult is any rider age 20 and over that has not loped in any class.

*Novice Horse* is any horse that has not loped in any class.

Once a novice horse or rider has competed in a loping class, they may <u>not</u> return to the novice division.

A rider that competes in a loping class may show a novice horse in the novice horse walk trot class.

The horse will be considered a novice until that horse has competed in a loping class

- \*Memberships are payable at any time during the year. Points for year-end awards begin to accumulate only after membership has been paid, not before. Membership year runs from January 1 to December 31 of each year.
