Classes 1- 4, 7A, 13,15, 21A, 33A, 36 & 37 do not count for Daily High Point.

High Points for: Pee Wee, Novice Horse, Novice Rider, 50 & Over, 35-49, 19-34, 14-18, 13 & Under

There will be a \$25.00 fee assessed for all checks returned by the bank for any reason.
