- ~ Age of Horse as of December 31, 2015

- ~ No one under the age of 18 will be allowed to show a stallion
- ~ Judge's decision is final
- ~ Back numbers must be purchased or chosen from those supplied by the show committee
- ~ All horses MUST have a current year negative Coggins Test
- ~ Classes do not count for Daily High Point 1,2,3,4,5,12,15, 19, 20, 26,27,28,36,37, 45,46,47,48
- ~ Daily High Points for: Pee Wee, Novice Horse, Novice Rider, 40 & Over, 39-20, 19-16, 15-13, 12
- ~ Jr. Horse 5 years and Under
- $^{\sim}$ Sr. Horse 6 years and over
- ~All horses must be stalled and bedding in stall. ~All dogs are to be leashed on grounds.

- ~ Camping Fees: \$25 per night and will be collected at the entry gate on Friday
- $^{\sim}$ Stall Fees: \$20 per day (Saturday/Sunday)
- $^{\sim}$ No class entry fee refunds after 8am the day of show, no transfer of entry fees to another rider, horse or entry.
- ~ No arrivals prior to Friday at 1pm (charges may apply).
- ~ Camping is on a first come first serve basis, no saving multiple spots.
- $^{\sim}$ There will be a \$25.00 fee assessed for all checks returned by the bank for any reason.
