- DAILY HIGH POINTS FOR: PEEWEE, NOVICE HORSE, NOVICE RIDER, WALK/TROT OPEN 18 & UNDER, WALK/TROT OPEN 19 & OVER, 40 & OVER, 19-39, 14-18, 13 & UNDER
- CLASSES THAT DO NOT COUNT FOR DAILY HIGH POINTS:  
1, 2, 3, 4, 5, 8, 16, 19, 20, 27, 28, 38, 49, 50
- JR. HORSE 5 YRS. & UNDER (MUST TURN IN A COPY OF REGISTRATION PAPERS TO OFFICE)
- SR. HORSE 6 YRS. AND OVER
- CAMPING FEES: \$25.00 PER NIGHT
- STALL FEES: \$20.00 PER SHOW DAY
- HAUL IN FEE \$10.00 PER DAY (New fairgrounds rule)

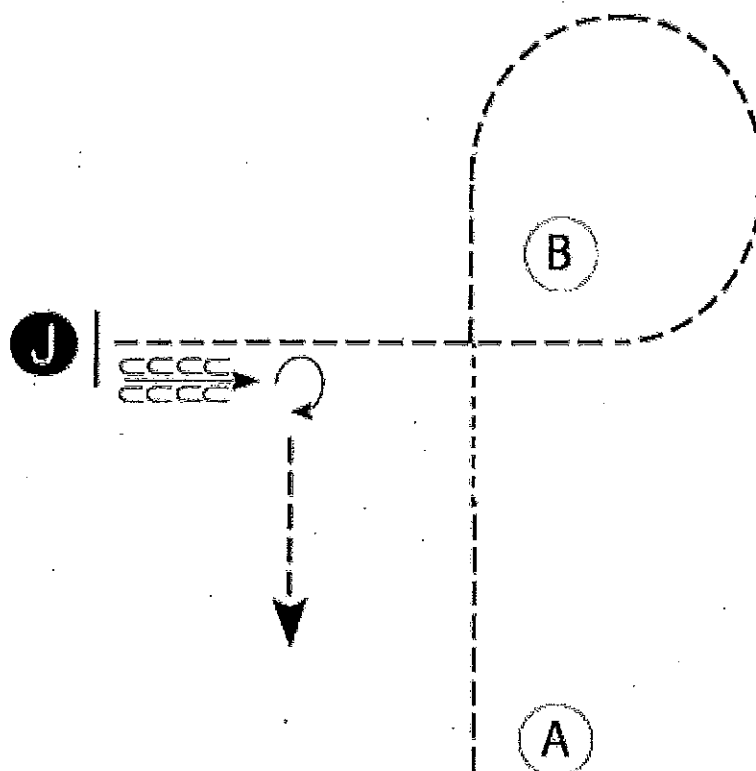

3. Trot to and around B as shown.
4. Trot to the judge. Stop and set up for inspection.
5. When dismissed, back approximately 2 horse lengths.
6. Perform a 270 degree turn and trot straight away.

# Ranch Riding PATTERN #56



Be ready at A.

1. Jog to B
2. Extend the jog in a half circle
3. Lope on the right lead until even with A
4. Perform a lead change, simple or flying
5. Lope on the left lead until even with A
6. Extend the jog to B
7. Stop at B and back approximately one horse length
8. Perform a 1 1/4 turn to the right and exit at jog.
